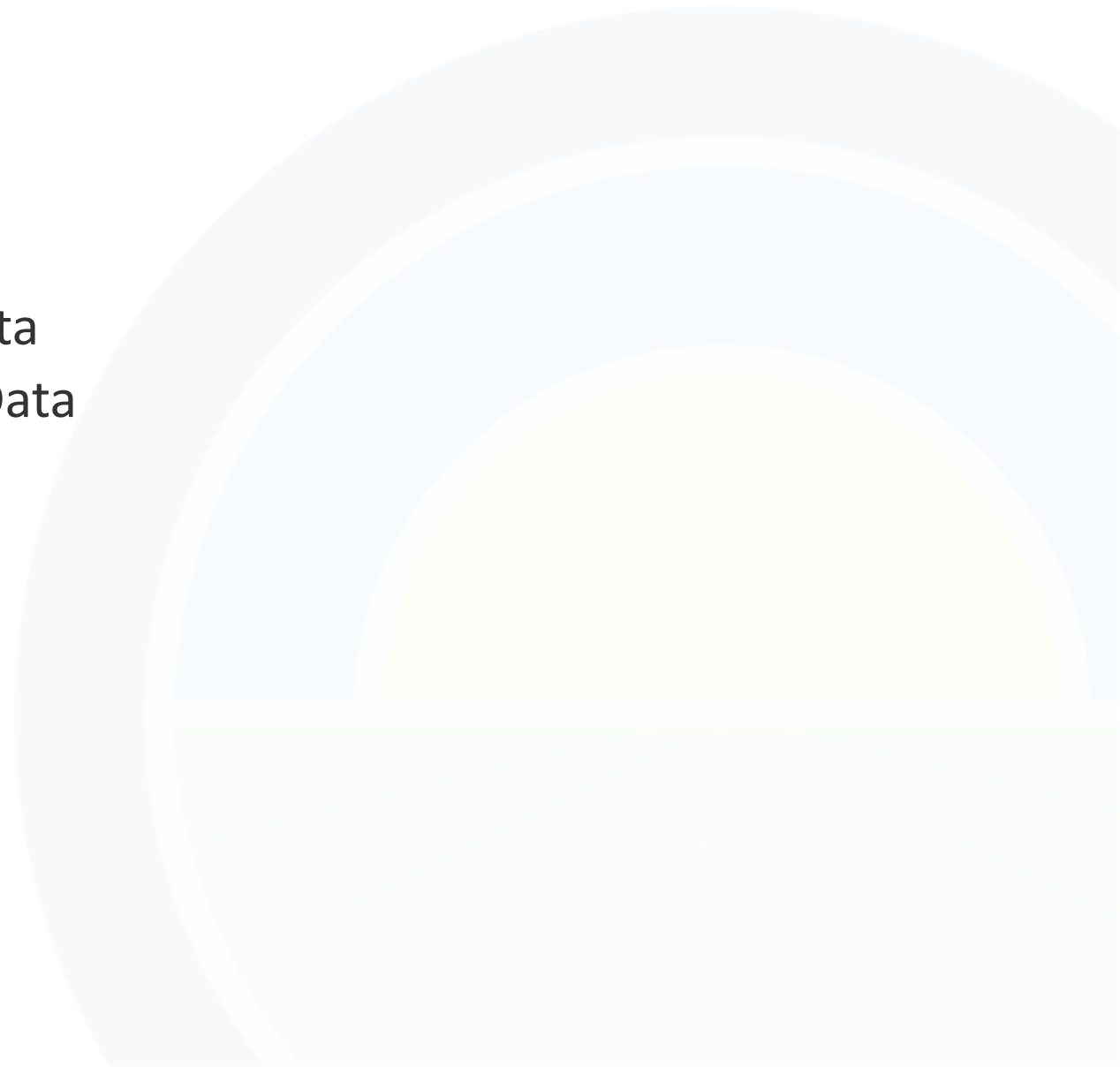

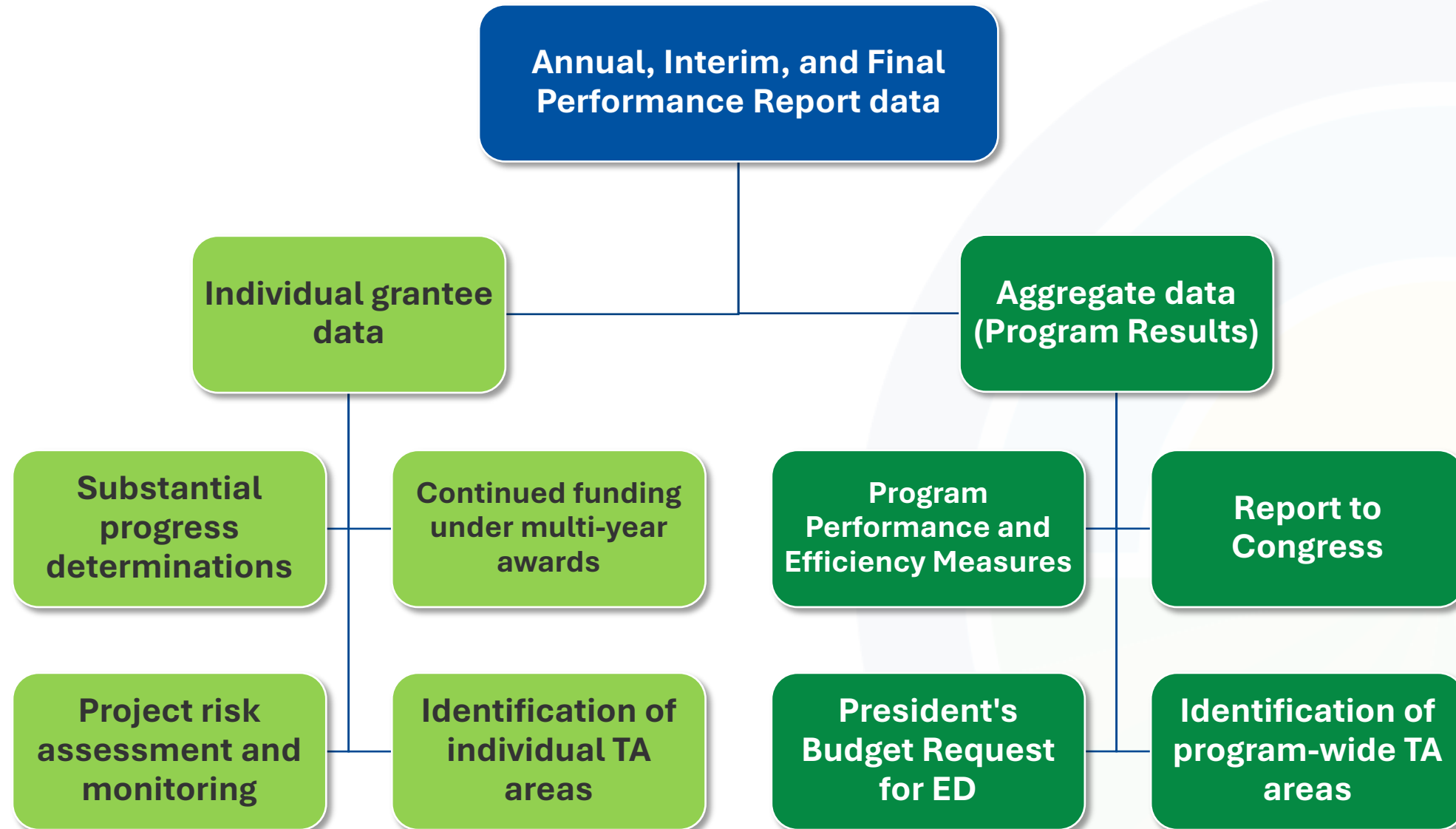

HEP Program Performance Measures

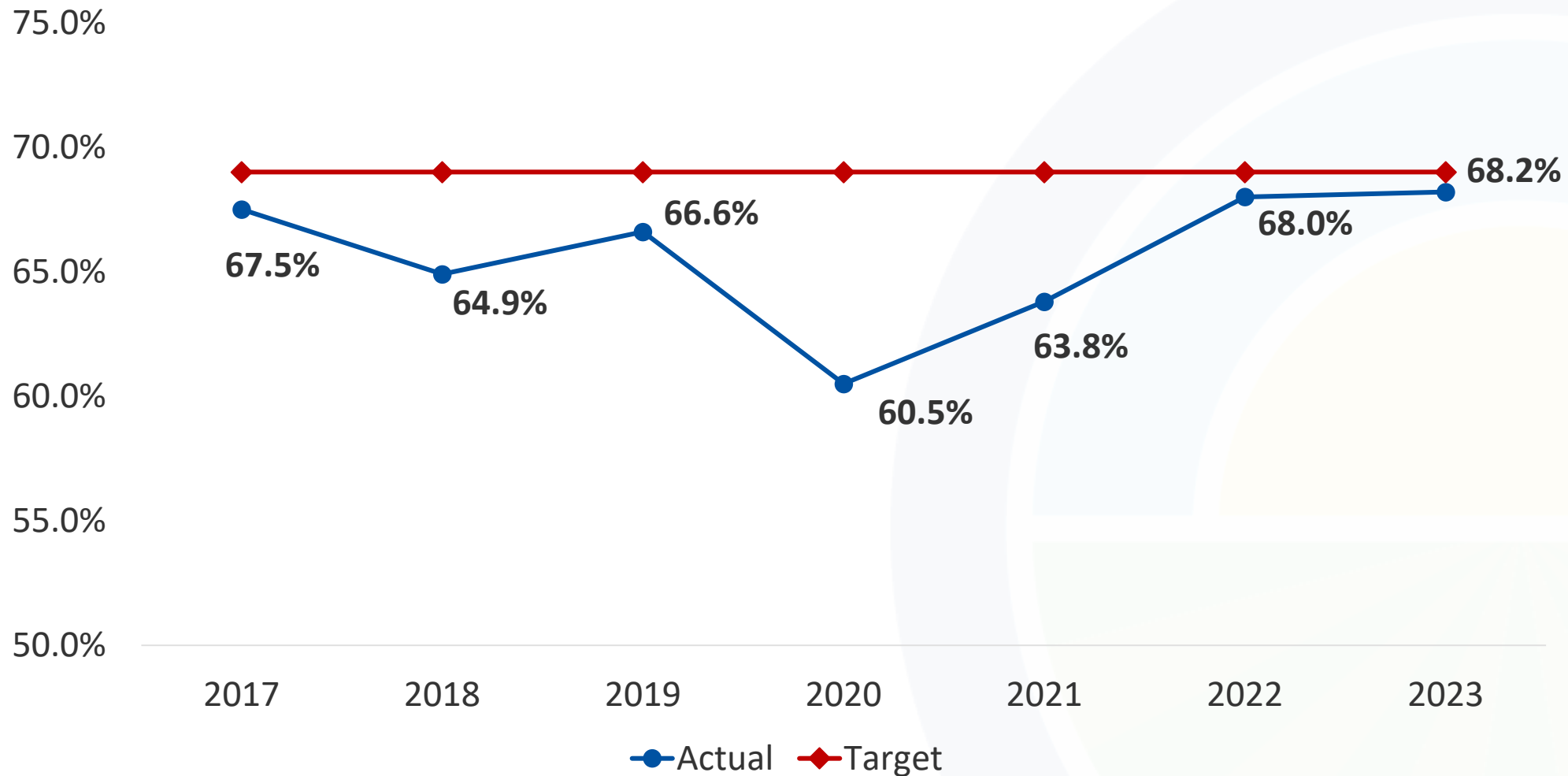
- **HEP Measure 1:** The percentage of HEP participants attaining a high school equivalency diploma (HSED).
- **HEP Measure 2:** The percentage of HEP HSED recipients who enter postsecondary education or training programs, upgraded employment, or the military.

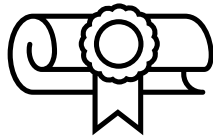

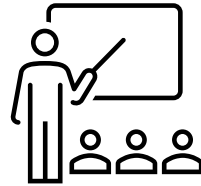

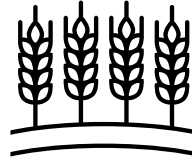

CAMP Program Performance Measures

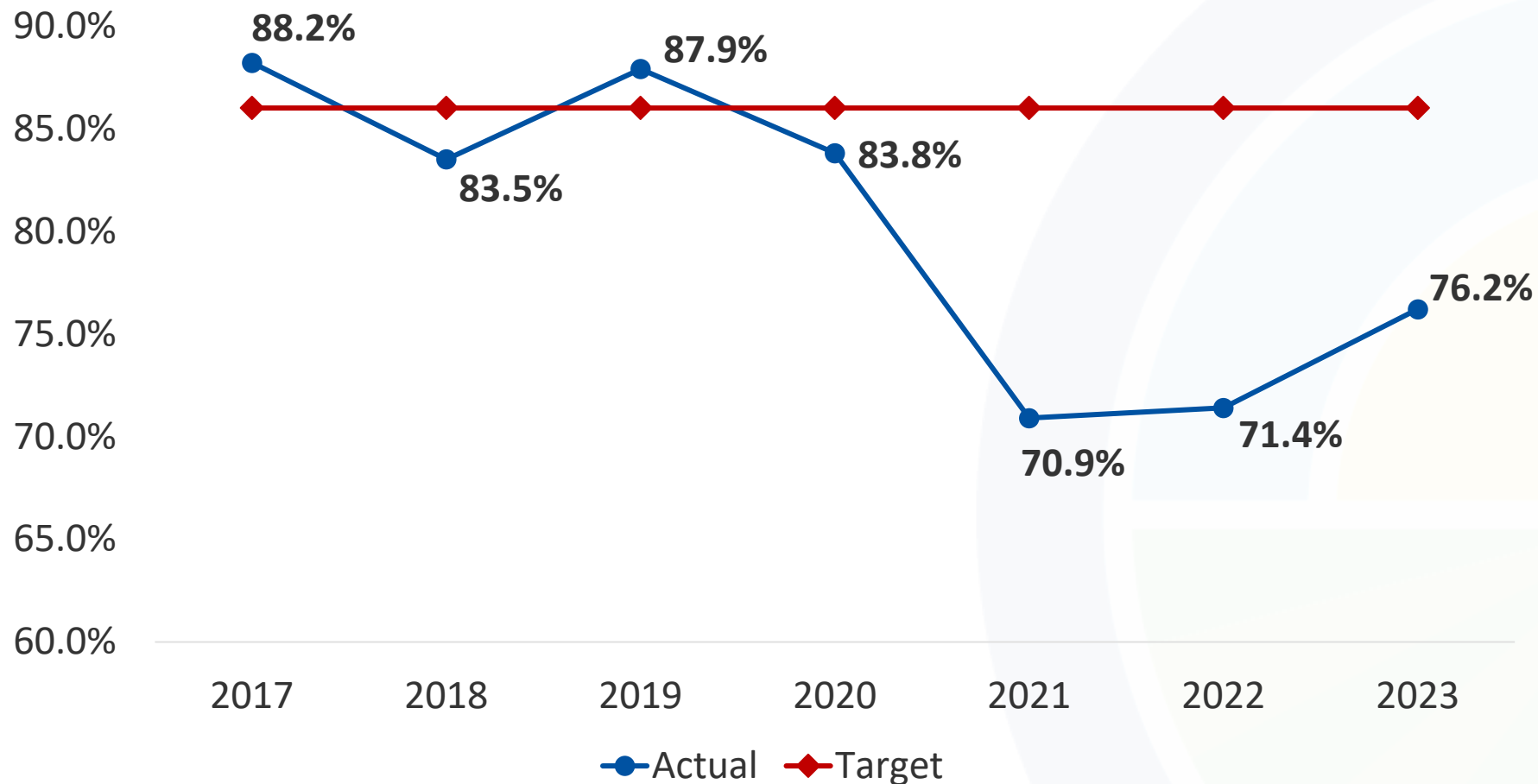
- **CAMP Measure 1:** The percentage of CAMP participants completing the first academic year of a postsecondary program in good standing.

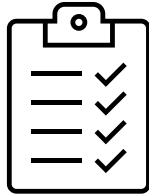

Measure 1 (National Target: 86%)

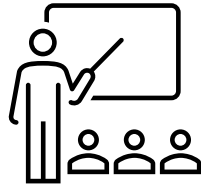

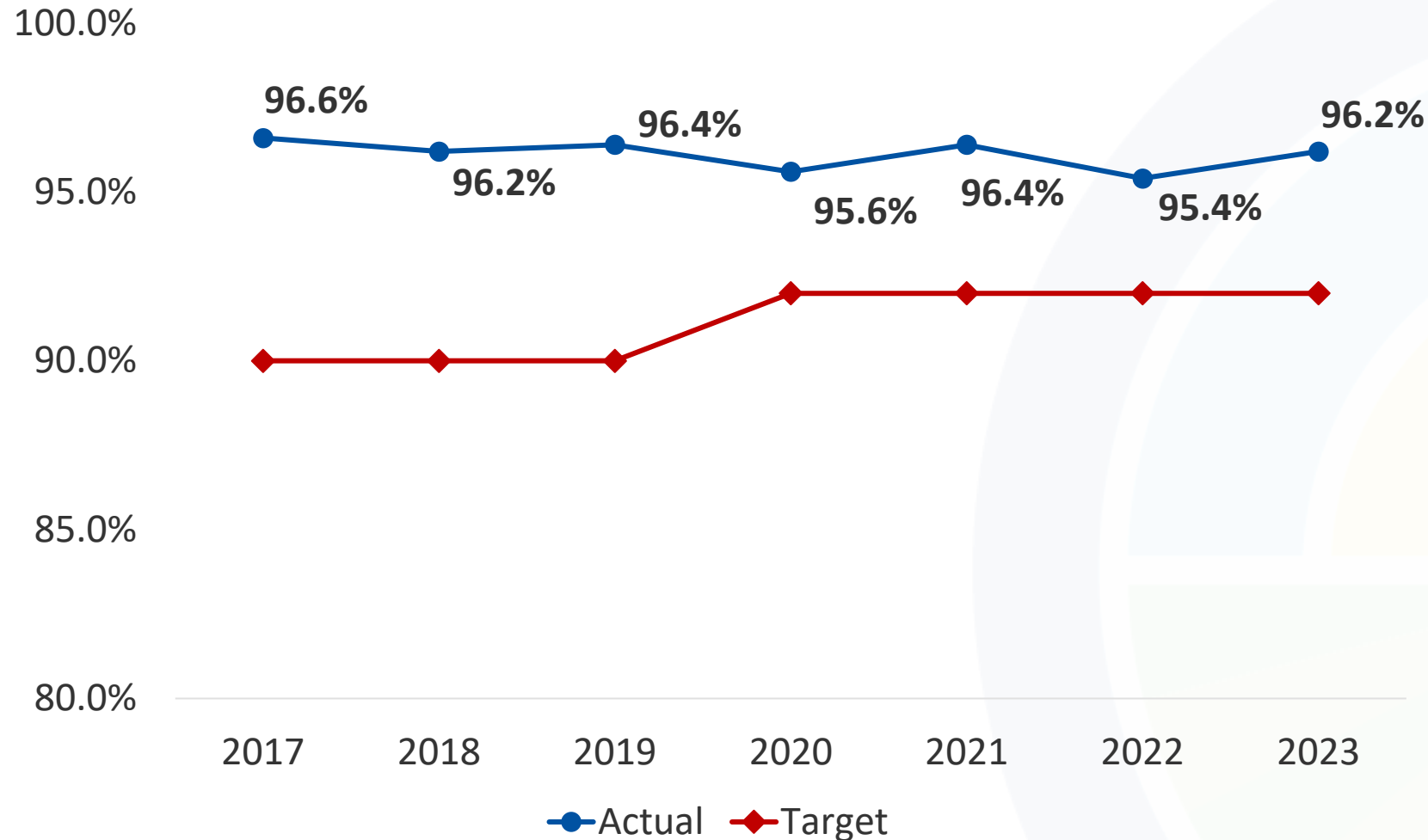

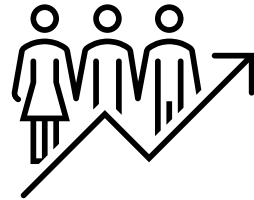

Performance Reporting

Annual Performance Report (APR) Due Dates

- The APR **Reporting Period** is aligned with the 12-month current budget period: **July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024**
- Due Date: Your final version of the APR must be submitted by **Thursday, October 17, 2024.**
- Due Date: The Final Performance Report must be submitted by **Monday, October 28, 2024.** If you receive a no-cost time extension from the U.S. Department of Education for the fifth year of this grant, the Final Performance Report is due **120 days** after the revised project period end date.

Interim Performance Report (IPR) Reporting Period

For new projects (FY24 cohort) and those projects that were notified of not making substantial progress for FY2022-23:

- The IPR Reporting Period is a 7-month period: **July 1, 2024 – January 24, 2025**
- Due Date: Your final version of the IPR must be submitted by **Thursday, February 6, 2025.**
