SUBJECT: Integrity, Security, and Effectiveness of Department of Education Procurement

Activities

As a valued partner in the federal contracting process, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of your ongoing obligations under federal acquisition regulations and policies, specifically regarding Organizational Conflict of Interest (OCI), Data Security, Records Management, and Ethics.

Your obligations are critical to ensuring the integrity, security, and effectiveness of federal procurement activities, and our national security. As a third party entrusted to manage government information, it is critical that you handle that information in a manner that upholds bedrock American principles and interests.

I am writing to remind you, our contractor partners, of essential responsibilities and ethical commitments included in our binding agreement. Non-compliance could result in termination and/or possible legal penalties. Therefore, I am encouraging you to review your responsibilities and the following clauses which have been included, as applicable, in the Department's contract with you:

Your adherence to contractual obligations is essential for maintaining a fair, secure, and ethical environment in federal contracting. Please review your internal processes to ensure compliance with OCI, data security, records management, and ethical obligations.

Additionally, please be mindful of your obligations to ensure that government information you handle or maintain is not exposed to any third parties not explicitly authorized by the Department to access such information. You are contractually prohibited from sharing government information with any other third party including, for example, consultants, accountants, and law firms, without express approval from the Department.
